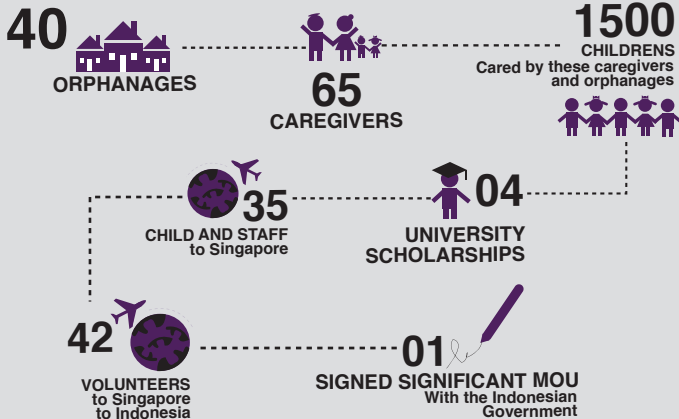


### PROFILE
